### History.

Set on the site of a former medieval village, the ancestral home of the Lovell family offers a superb shooting ground steeped in history for the traditional longbow archer.

Lord Francis Lovell escaped the Battle of Bosworth Field in 1485, but his body was found walled up at Minster Lovell some years later. The shoot is held by kind permission of the school that now occupies the site.
